



from the Pastor

Preachers often express the humorous statement to each other about challenges they face in church with the phrase, "I never learned that in seminary." Seminary is vital training for ministry types but not every situation that comes up in church life is addressed in the hallowed halls of a seminary. Here's one that I never learned in Seminary: *How do you lead a church to reopen services after quarantine during a pandemic?* Perhaps today's students will explore this in the years ahead and

probably learn from our mistakes and successes.

As re-opening of some meetings at FBC begins, I'd like to give you a challenge.

First, let's agree to respect each other's strong views about the pandemic. Respect means to have "*a due regard for the feelings, wishes, rights or traditions of others.*" The pandemic has certainly caused a wide gamut of opinions. While some hold that it's all a political conspiracy, others say it's a health crisis of life and death. I don't know who is right. But I know the Bible teaches: (1 Peter 2:17) — Show proper respect to everyone, love the family of believers, fear God, honor the emperor.

Second, let's agree to be more concerned about others than ourselves. Again the Bible instructs us: (1 Corinthians 10: 24) — No one should seek their own good, but the good of others. We don't have to change everyone's opinion to match ours. Instead, we can move beyond worldly selfishness to value others in the Body of Christ. One of the ways that the body of Christ shows its beauty best is when people "with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love" are "eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (Ephesians 4:2-3).

Third, let's agree to be flexible. As we open up our meetings to give more and more people the chance to be together, things may look a lot different for a while. Most of these things will be temporary. We just don't know how long 'temporary' will last. So, try some new things and realize this is a season in the life of FBC. You may have to sit somewhere different, wear something different, or interact differently for a time.

Finally, let's agree to celebrate our coming together. The staff and leadership of First Baptist Church have done our best to minister during this strange time. Hopefully when we meet in the near future, we'll be grateful for the chance to be together.

Let's remember our purpose in coming together. Our purpose is to honor and glorify Jesus Christ who is our Savior and our Lord. Any other reason is far secondary.






