Q & A with the Pastor

Q: When will we be able to meet again at full capacity?

Because of our unique situation this year, I have asked all who are serving as leaders to continue in their leadership role for one more year. I think a leadership change in the middle of these days would be confusing and difficult to pull off. I'm grateful that most of our leaders have agreed to continue in their service. I'm especially grateful to our Deacons as all 21 men agreed to continue for one more year.

Q: When will we have another Quarterly Business Meeting?

A: As the ministry of FBC continues, I am committed to finding a way for those interested to know all the details of what's going on and what's planned. We hope to have a meeting near the end of August which will likely include an online option for attendance.


