



#### FROM THE PASTOR

A few years ago, my family and I decided to go to one of those 'Escape Rooms'. Escape Rooms are an interactive adventure experience where a team is 'locked' in a room and must solve riddles and use a series of clues to 'break out.' It's a bit like being inside a video game. As my family began working through the clues and riddles, I found it fascinating how much energy we generated. With great momentum we were committed to beat the

clock and 'escape'. I also learned that some in my family are far better at clues and riddles than I am, (but don't tell them I admitted that.)

One of the insights our family gained from the Escape Room experience was that we did better when we worked together and utilized the strengths of each person. My daughter-in-law was great at figuring out the riddles. My son was fearless in trying things and didn't get discouraged when we had to regroup and start again. My daughter kept encouraging us to stay focused on one task at a time. Melinda kept reminding us that we didn't need to get distracted because the clock was running.

As I reflect on that enjoyable time in my family, I think about our family of faith at FBC. 1 Corinthians 12 reminds us that the church functions as a body. Christ is the head and gives gifts to us. These gifts help us with the important responsibilities of His work. Verse 12 says, "For just as the body is one and yet has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ."

Every Christian brings something to the Body of the Church. We hamper the work of the church when we refuse to get involved or think we don't matter. We also hamper the work of the church when we neglect the giftedness of each person.

Most of us have never been in a church fellowship that functioned as 1 Corinthians 12 describes. I'd like for First Baptist to be that kind of church.

1 Corinthians 12 teaches us that we don't have to go to an Escape Room to know we do better when we work together. Let's be about the things God calls us to do together in unity.


