



FROM THE PASTOR

The central teaching of Christianity is that Jesus Christ is alive forevermore. He was crucified on Friday but early on Sunday, God raised Him from the dead. A lot can change in three days.

We've all experienced long days; a workday that drags on and on, motivating your child to do homework, sitting with a loved one in a hospital room. A long day seems to last more

than twenty-four hours.

Yet on the other side of long days, our perspective may change. In hindsight, the day might not seem as long.

I can't imagine how long the days between the crucifixion and the resurrection must have seemed to the disciples. Their world had crashed. Their leader was gone. They were hiding out afraid they might be put to death next.

The news of Easter changed their world. Their perspective changed. Seeing the resurrected Jesus filled them with joy and gave them a passionate mission that carried them for the rest of their lives. The long days were replaced with the joyous news of the resurrection.

Jesus had taught them this central truth.

John 10:10 - The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. (NIV)

The phrase 'to the full' is often translated as 'abundantly'. The word gets to the idea of something 'beyond what is anticipated.'

What an uncommon life Jesus invites us to live! Easter teaches us that in Jesus we can know life beyond what is anticipated. Long days are not wasted and they're followed by the promise of life beyond expectation. A lot changes in three days. Easter proves it.


