



FROM THE PASTOR

Some habits are hard to break, and some habits are hard to start. Since the beginning of the pandemic, First Baptist Church has sought to navigate a balancing act between keeping our ministries safe for participants and still active and effective. Thank you for your constant prayers and support as our church has been flexible. The truth is, God has blessed First Baptist Church during this time. We've baptized many people, we've added people to our fellowship, we've had guests visit us regularly, and our church has been generous in tithes and offerings. I

Yet the work of reaching our community with the Gospel of Jesus Christ never ends. We are always privileged by God to share the love, grace, and forgiveness of God with others.

At FBC, we've used a series of questions to remind us of some basic habits we develop in reaching our community. For this article, I'm calling them: Four questions for February (and beyond).

- 1. Who's Your One? I know, we've asked this question before, but I think it's still a valuable question. Who is the one, or who are the several people, you are praying for about their relationship with Jesus Christ? Many people in our community need to hear of God's salvation through Jesus. Will you pray for one or several?
- **2.** Who are Your Five? This is a question about your discipleship. Will you get involved in a small group based around The Bible that challenges you to grow as a disciple of Jesus? Starting the habit of being a disciple is important and meaningful.
- **3.** How can I pray for you? This is a question you can ask almost anyone especially unchurched people. I've never asked someone if I could pray for them or with them and had someone say 'no'. You'd be surprised how quickly the walls come down when you ask someone if you can pray with them. It shows you care.
- 4. Will you sit with me? When was the last time you invited someone to come to church with you? Lifeway research shows that 80% of people who are asked to come to church by someone they know come. Many people just need a little encouragement and the knowledge that they won't be alone if they come to church.

As we celebrate 180 years of ministry in 2022, we remember that God has put us here in this season to continue to be a beacon of hope in our community.






