



FROM THE PASTOR

May 1, 2022, begins the celebration of 180 years (1842-2022) of ministry for First Baptist Church. Periodically throughout the remainder of the year, FBC will celebrate and remember God's faithful leadership. We will also give renewed focus to God's continued call inviting FBC to follow Him.

In 1842, John Tyler was President of the United States. Perhaps best known for the campaign slogan "Tippecanoe and Tyler, too," Tyler became the first US Vice-President to ascend to the presidency after the death of President William Henry Harrison (nicknamed Tippecanoe).

Tyler served only one term as President (1841-1845) and did not seek re-election.

In Mississippi, Tilghman Tucker became Governor in 1842. Tucker was the first Governor to live in the Governor's Mansion in Jackson. His administration was rocked by scandal as the State Treasurer embezzled \$44,000 and escaped to Canada.

In Oxford, a town only five years old in 1842, a group of Christians, desiring a Baptist church, met and organized. May 8, 1842, the group of six, led by the Pastor, Hosea Holcomb, signed the Minute sheet establishing the Baptist Church in Oxford. The location of the meeting was likely the Butler Inn, then at the corner of North Lamar and the square. B.W Butler and his wife owned the Inn and were two of the church's charter members.

The rest, as they say, is history.

So many great people have been part of FBC Oxford through the years. One of those is Dr. Gene Neal. Gene served as Minister of Activities from 1982 to 1985 and has pastored First Baptist Church, Quitman, Mississippi since 2000. Gene will be preaching in our morning worship services on May 1.

We will remember much of our history this year. We will enjoy stories and photos from the past. We will appreciate those who have gone before us. We will make a new Church Pictorial Directory. Most of all, we will commit to following our Leader, the same Head of the Church now as in 1842, our Lord Jesus Christ.


