



FROM THE PASTOR

Electronic devices are famous for needing to be reset at times. A 'reset button' on a computer "clears the computer's memory and causes it to reboot, clearing any pending errors or events and brings the system to normal condition or the initial state." (Cambridge Dictionary) Other things have reset buttons: garbage disposals, Roku devices, a Blink camera, even some air conditioning units.

The Apostle Paul sounds like he's talking about a reset button in Philippians 3:13-14.

Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

The new year can serve as something of a reset button in our lives.

In this passage of Philippians, Paul sounds like a motivational speaker whipping the crowd into a frenzy with the words ...

"... one thing I do

It's a joyous shout - "ONE THING!" One ultimate focus in his life. The One thing was something for which he was passionate. Like the sprinter in a photo finish race, muscles bulging, chest out, head tilted forward, focused on the ribbon held across the finish line... Paul points to an aspect of the reset: focus on the prize of Jesus!

"... forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead,"

The Reset Button of focusing on one thing comprises forgetting and straining. The words 'forgetting' and "straining' rhyme in the Greek language. The rhyming idea in English would be something like 'erasing the past and chasing the future.' To focus on the prize, we can't get distracted by past mistakes nor future distractions.

And here's the one thing...

"I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus."

Paul had determined the focus of his life. That goal is the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. He no longer hears the voice of critics or others who distract. Up ahead of him and above him is another call, the call of that voice he first heard on the Damascus Road.

With the turning of the calendar to 2023, perhaps it's time for all of us to hit the 'reset button' by moving on from the past and pressing on to a deeper faith in Jesus. FBC exists to help.
